

Egypt's EE codes for residential buildings (2006)




Egypt's EE codes for commercial buildings (2006)

Buildings that go beyond the national standards are eligible for financing under GEFF, however, so far we do not have a case study of EE buildings (in spite of the booming market demand in the industrial sector).



Technology Selector



Sectors Eligible for Financing Under GEFF



The following are the sub-sectors eligible for financing under GEFF, according to the ones with highest electricity consumption profiles:

- Residential (compounds, financing developers not households)
- Tourism (hotels)
- Health care (hospitals)
- Commercial & mixed-use buildings

Buildings Investments Eligible for Financing Under GEFF



The following partial investments are eligible for financing under the current GEFF Programme:

- Renewables (PV, SWH)
- EE Lighting
- Green construction material (Greenfield projects)
- HVAC
- Building management systems
- Insulations
- Energy efficient water technologies (e.g. pumps for swimming pools)
- Fuel switch of centralized heaters/boilers not energy efficiency but GHG emissions reduction
- Water efficiency (low flow plumbing fixtures)

Accelerating 0-Emissions Buildings-Beyond Financing




What GEFF may offer beyond direct financing:

- Fostering policy dialogue on energy efficient buildings.
- Technical assistance to the Egyptian Government (update of building standards for higher energy performance).
- Financing for demonstration projects to disseminate the knowledge about benefits.
- Capacity building of banking professionals on sustainable energy & trainings for engineers of developers
- Awareness raising: financial & environmental benefits of energy efficiency measures and best practices.
